## **Covid Update – Changes starting March**

The Government of Ontario has announced that effective March 1, 2022, changes to the COVID-19 protocols will take place, provided that health and health care indicators continue to improve.

As a backdrop to the following norms for Parishes in the Diocese of Hamilton, it should be noted, that we need to proceed and re-open cautiously, especially since the pandemic has not concluded.

# St. Thomas will now operate at full capacity with continued mandatory mask wearing.

The following changes to the COVID-19 protocols will take place:

- The use of Holy Water is permitted; please sanitize your hands as you enter the church. Sanitizing stations continue to be offered.
- Congregational singing and Choir singing is permitted provided they were masks.
- Cantors may be unmasked provided they are 3meter distance from others.
- Communion in the hand continues to be highly encouraged. Those who wish to receive it on the tongue should receive it at the end of the Communion procession. Communion from the Chalice is not permitted at this time.
- The sign of peace by shaking hands if discouraged at this time.
- Negative tests for un-vaccinated staff, volunteers or liturgical ministers are no longer required.

While there can be no guarantee of complete protection, every reasonable precaution has been and will continue to be taken by the parish to protect your health and safety. Thank you for your patience.

#### Stations of the Cross - Fridays at 7pm

Beginning on Friday, March 4th at 7pm, we will celebrate the Stations of the Cross. The Stations of the Cross are a 14-step devotion that commemorates Jesus Christ's last day on Earth as a man. The 14 stations focus on specific events of His last day, beginning with His condemnation. The stations are commonly used as a mini pilgrimage as the individual moves from station to station. At each station, the individual recalls and meditates on a specific event from Christ's last day. Specific prayers are recited, then the individual moves to the next station until all 14 are complete.
